WHAT IS FACEBOOK PAGE REQUEST?

A Facebook request makes it possible for Nexta to get access to our customer's Facebook page and thereby do advertisement on the customer's behalf.



However, the Facebook page will still belong to the current owner.

HOW TO SEND A FACEBOOK PAGE REQUEST

Login to Nexta.io and click in the right corner on Client Management. In Client Management go to Facebook and you will see the following:
